He has participated in the most of the major music festivals all over India and USA, Canada, Austria, Italy, Germany, Mauritius, South Korea many times. He has been accompanying regularly with very eminent musicians, both vocalists and instrumentalists.

Tapash has been selected for “Fellowship for Outstanding Artist” from the Department of Culture, Government of India. He worked as a Visiting Lecturer in Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Culture, Mauritius. For a decade Tapash has been broadcasting from All India Radio, telecasting from Doordarshan India and other private T.V. Channels.
